

Governance Review and Traffic

South Norfolk Council have accepted our suggestions for simplification of the Parish boundary which currently wanders across the Watton Rd and around long gone fields. The new boundary (shown in yellow) will give us a greater say over the roads that feed traffic into the village and this will help us press for cycle paths and measures to deter through traffic. Currently the Little Melton Business Park is actually in Hethersett and we are not consulted about developments there. **However** in order for these changes to be effected we need to demonstrate public support so please complete the short response that is linked from the News page at www.little-melton.org.uk.



The PC still needs help from people prepared to read planning documents for Hethersett and the Research Park and to develop our case to ensure that road changes outside the village don't create worse problems here.
