The Trustees have held two meetings in the past year as well as the annual inspection of the allotments. Nearly fifty allotments are currently tenanted and generally cultivated to a very high standard.

The Best Kept Allotment award was given to J Morton.

The first compensation payment in respect of the Hornsea Project has been received.

The two allotment sites have been registered with the Land Registry.

A water supply has been provided for the Great Melton Road site.

The ditches have been cleared and tree work is ongoing.

Wendy Kimberley has generously donated £120 to the Charity following the sale of her art work in the village shop.

Income for the year to 30th November 2018 included the compensation payment in respect of the Hornsea project. £4163.31 was paid to beneficiaries and professional fees amounted to £2400. Surplus funds for the year available for community projects are £3697.66.

Financial assistance continues to be considered by the Trustees mostly for help with domestic fuel costs and school trips. The primary aim of the Charity is to provide assistance to the residents of the Little Melton area who are suffering need, hardship or distress. All applications are considered in strict confidence.
